Training on E-mail Using for Provincial Election Commission Officials

On January 19, 2007, the NEC organized a training course for 24 provincial election commission officials on using electronic data sending (E-mail) such as: the 2007 voting results and distribution of commune council seats in order to have a faster communication during the elections.

Mr. Hoen Rong, Chief of Department of Operation, stated that after the training, the NEC will distribute one computer set to each PEC with installed software for calculation the distribution of seats and with connection to e-mail in order to communicate the NEC.

H.E. Tep Nytha, NEC Secretary General, stated in his closing speech that sending data via e-mail since 2002 resulted in a more effective communication, then through post office, fax, and radio.

He stressed that the main points is to receive clear information with complete correct documents. But he added that if the information and documents are initially sent unclear, it the information and documents sent through e-mail will remain unclear.
